Who are intercultural parent mentors?

Parent Mentors:

- are volunteers who are committed to enabling collaboration through facilitating, communication between parents and educational institutions.
- are neutral and confidential contact people for parents, educators and teachers.
- help in building a common understanding between parents and educational institutions.
- are familiar with the perspective and role of parents.
- are qualified people that are certified from the non-profit parent foundation of Baden-Württemberg.



Which languages do the parent mentors speak?

In Baden-Baden, intercultural parent mentors support the newly immigrated families with the following language skills, among others: Albanian, Amharic, Arabic, Bulgarian, Chinese, English, French, Italian, Kurdish, Polish, Romanian, Russian, Spanish, Turkish, Tigrinya, Ukrainian, Hungarian.

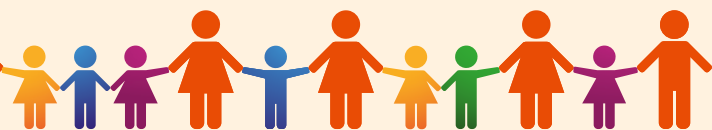


What do parent mentors do exactly?

Parent Mentors ...

- are available as mediators to parents seeking help and educational institutions.
- provide information about the German School System (e.g. the transition to secondary school).
- help with language difficulties.
- accompany and moderate conversations between parents, educators and teachers (e.g. in the event of conflicts).
- listen to concerns from parents and/or educators and help resolve or clarify them.
- establish contact with families from different cultures.
- are mediators between kindergarten / schools and parents if necessary.
- treat all topics with the utmost confidentiality.
- can implement initiatives such as information evenings, parent cafés etc. that strengthen parental involvement at school, kindergarten, day care center, in the club etc.

- School social workers & socio-pedagogical specialists
- Consultants from institutions and facilities that work independent of schools to support families with an immigration background.
